Boarding Risks, Policies, Emergency Info and Consent to Care

Thank you for choosing Prairie Hills Animal Hospital Pet Hotel for your pet's boarding needs!

Boarding your pet in ANY facility brings with it an inherent risk of your pet contracting contagious diseases and other ailments such as upper respiratory infections in cats, Bordetella (Kennel Cough) in dogs, as well as intestinal parasites, fleas, and ticks. The risk can be even greater in a veterinary hospital where animals with these illnesses may be hospitalized.

Here at Prairie Hills Pet Hotel, we make every effort to prevent the spread of any potentially infectious threat. We do this by maintaining strict vaccine & stool sample requirements for boarding pets, isolating any animals that we feel may be contagious in a dedicated isolation room, and thoroughly cleaning cages and runs with an antibacterial & antiviral disinfectant throughout the day.

Pets boarding with us MUST have had a negative stool exam within the past 6 months AND have the following vaccinations up-to-date at least 14 days prior to boarding:

Cats: FVRCP, Rabies

Dogs: DA2PP-L, Rabies, Bordetella

Even with these precautions, it is impossible both to predict when a contagious animal may come into the hospital and to completely remove the possibility of that animal passing its illness on to other pets while it is here.

I understand my pets will be in close proximity to other animals, and that there is an inherent risk of infectious disease when boarding my pet in any boarding facility, especially a veterinary hospital.

I understand that my pets are required to be current on vaccines and have a negative stool exam as listed above and that if I cannot produce proof of vaccination and a negative fecal examination at least 2 days prior to the start of boarding, Prairie Hills Animal Hospital reserves the right to cancel my reservation. I understand the risks of infectious diseases as outlined above and assume all financial responsibility should my pet contract an illness or other ailment while boarding at Prairie Hills Animal Hospital.

I understand that a veterinarian will not be in the building outside of business hours, including over the weekend, but one of the staff veterinarians will be contacted by kennel staff if there is any concern regarding my pet during these times.

I also understand that if my pet is not picked up on or before the scheduled check-out date and the change in check-out date was not confirmed with the clinic, increased boarding costs will be charged. Any pet that is not claimed within 10 days of the scheduled pick-up date (without new provisions being made) will be considered abandoned. At that point, Prairie Hills will handle the situation according to our best judgment. It is understood that such actions do not relieve me of paying all costs of services.

MEDIA WAIVER: Occasionally, my or my pet's likeness may be captured in picture or video form without compensation.

I hereby DECLINE Prairie Hills Animal Hospital to use, broadcast, and/or reproduce my and my pet's likeness in video, print, or other media, including social media.

I hereby APPROVE Prairie Hills Animal Hospital to use, broadcast, and/or reproduce my and my pet's likeness in video, print, or other media, including social media.

Choose ONE of the following options:

If an emergency situation arises, I authorize services to treat my animal until I can be contacted. In the event that I am unreachable, Prairie Hills has authorization to treat my pet as necessary for his/her health and well-being. I understand that I am financially responsible for all charges incurred during the boarding time and that they shall be paid in full prior to picking up my pet.

I DECLINE any and all treatment in the event of emergency if I or my authorized emergency contact are unable to be reached. I understand that this could mean leaving my pet in a potentially life-threatening situation. I incur all risk by declining treatment and will not hold Prairie Hills or any of its veterinarians or staff liable in the event that my pet endures undue pain, suffering, or death due to

declining treatments.

CPR/DNR Directive

Consent to Medical Treatment and CPR Directive: In the unlikely event that your pet will require resuscitative measures, please read the following directive, and choose one of the options for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). During sedation and anesthetic procedures, life threatening complications such as respiratory and/or cardiac arrest may occur, requiring medication treatment and/or CPR. If my pet stops breathing or his/her heart stops beating, I realize even the most successful CPR measures may not restore him/her to good mental and physical health.

- **Level 1:** NO CPR procedures are to be administered. DO NOT PERFORM CPR ON MY PET.
- **Level 2:** Endotracheal tube intubation, positive pressure respiration, administration of emergency drugs, external cardiac massage (chest compressions). **In the event that life-saving measures are necessary for your pet, additional costs will be incurred.*
